## Camp Location 2024

The Camp will take place at the **Reykjanes Peninsula**.

**Reykjanesbær** is the main town in this area with around 21.000 inhabitants, there are shops and various services for the region and of course the main international airport.

Members of the Lions Clubs from this area will be overseeing the Youth Camp while it is in Reykjanes and everyone is looking forward to hosting it.

In Reykjanes peninsula we have also 3 other smaller villages, Grindavík with about 3.700 inhabitants, Vogar with about 1.400 and Suðurnesjabær with about 3.800.

The Blue Lagoon is the most popular place to visit for most tourists, it is only about 20-30 minutes away. Also situated there is a big Geothermal Power Plant which provides all the electricity and hot water for the inhabitants of Reykjanes Peninsula.
