Our main offer is:

- Live 1 to 2 weeks in homestay with a caring host family
- Planned excursions, culture, sports and activities
- Improve your international language skills
- Low camp fee (some with no fee at all)
- Make friends with young people from other countries

Exploring Germany and delving into its rich culture is a transformative experience for many reasons. Learning the German language opens doors to a vibrant world of literature, philosophy, and art. 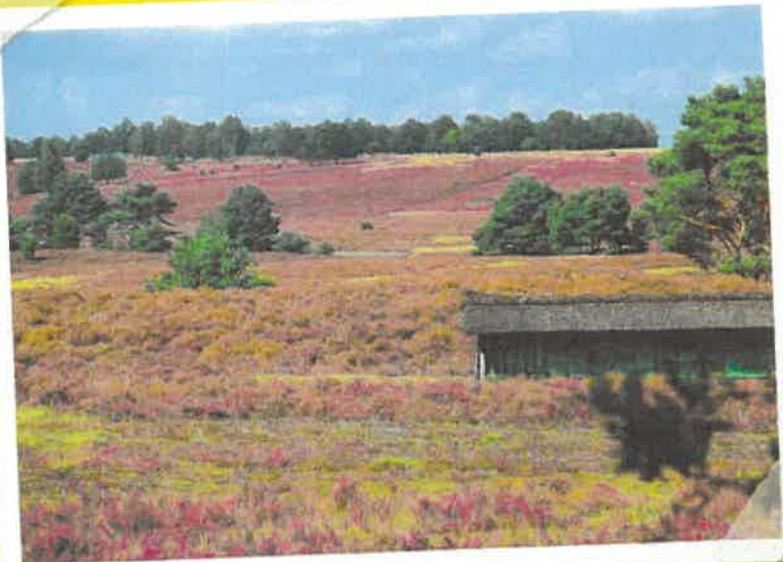

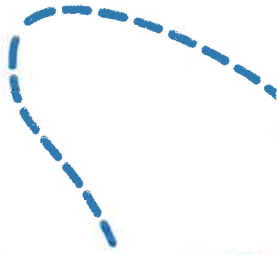

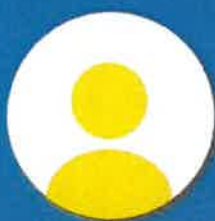
📍 INT. BAVARIAN LIONS YOUTH CAMP
